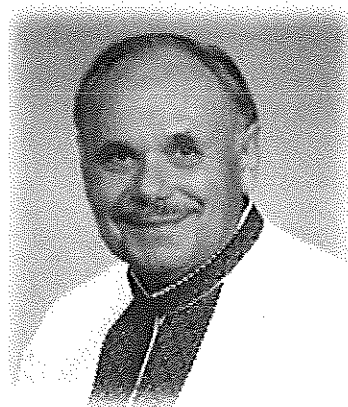


APPLICATION

Philosophy

This scholarship is intended to recognize a student who is or will be attending university, community college, or seminary. The scholarship is to be awarded to a student who has achieved academic excellence, a high level of school, community and religious/cultural involvement, and who has demonstrated maturity, responsibility, initiative, and strength of character towards achievement of higher education.

Eligible applicants must be either a child or grandchild of a member of St. Vladimir Ukrainian Orthodox Cathedral parish or a parish member themselves. The scholarship selection committee shall take into account an applicants:

- Involvement in school/community in general
- Involvement in their church and cultural activities
- Future career/goals
- Adversity overcome

1. A factual list of principal interests and activities while in school, including awards, offices held, plus other extracurricular, athletic and religious/cultural participation. The list should be in chronological order and cover only the last 3 years.
2. An essay of no more than 250 words explaining how your church/faith and cultural roots have impacted your life thus far and how continuing your education will contribute to attainment of your long term objectives and responsibilities in your career and future.
3. A photocopy of your grade transcripts covering the current and previous year.
4. Two letters of reference, one academic and one activity/community related. Letters, preferably, should be typed and when possible, on letterhead stationery. Letters of reference must arrive in a sealed envelope with the author's name written across the flap, along with the application.

I have given complete and true information. I understand if the scholarship were awarded, it would be paid directly to the post secondary institution on behalf of my educational obligation for the upcoming academic year/semester. I will keep a copy of my application and all supporting documentation in the event that I am required to produce this information for audit or verification purposes.
